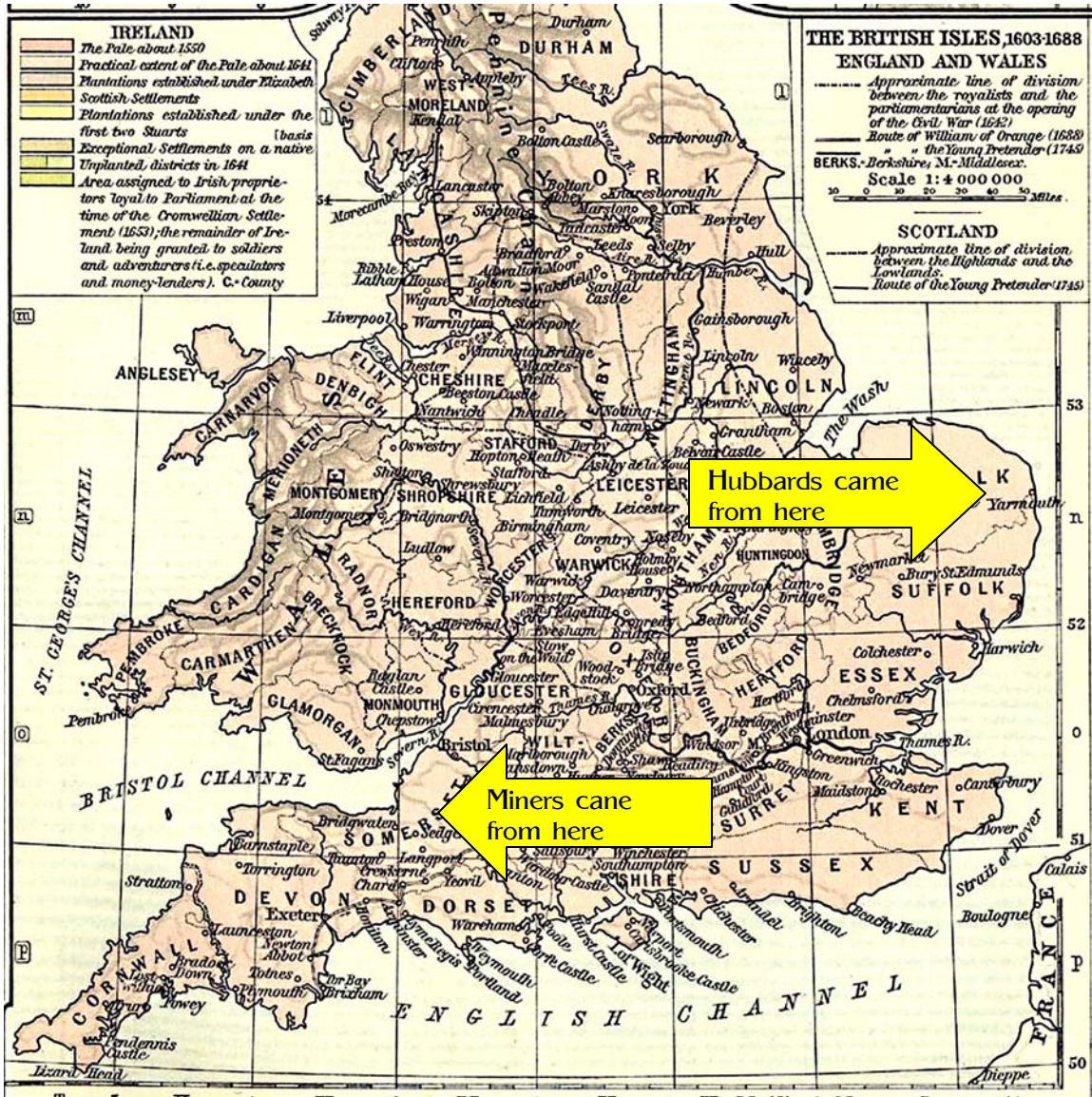

The above map show that the area where the oldest known Miners were located is in the south of England while the Hubbards came from eastern England. The Miners were from Chew-Magna

and Mendippe Hills. The two places are only a few miles apart. Eight generations of Miners lived in Chew-Magna.

The surname of Miner originated in England during the reign of King Edward III, whose reign continued from 1327-77. When preparing for war with France he took progress through Somerset, and coming to Mendippe Hill, where lived a man by the name of Bullman, whose extraordinary and successful efforts to aid the king in the munitions of war, with 100 powerful men of volunteers in the service, so pleased the king that he granted him a coat-of-arms, with the name of Henry Miner thereon, in recognition of his loyalty and patriotic devotion to him and his cause. This Henry Miner d. 1359, leaving four sons, heirs-at-law of the realm

WILLIAM MINER (MINOR, MYNAR) is listed as a resident paying taxes (one of 13) in North Elm section of Chew Magna, Somerset, England in 1523 (Paid 4p tax on goods assessed at 2£4s.). He received a Chew Magna house and land grant on 29 June 1554 with his son Thomas and Thomas' wife, Joan. He was buried at Chew Magna on 23 February 1585/6.

He may be related to John Minere who appears on a Chew Magna manor account roll for the year 1494-5 as paying for grass on 46 acres of meadow or to Joan Minere, a widow, who appears on that roll as paying a tax known as churchscot.

Some records claim that Isabella Harcope was of royal blood whose mother was Elizabeth PLANTAGENET and father was John d'La Pole. However, this has proven to be ridiculous.

THOMAS MINER of Chew Magna, Somerset, England was born roughly 1530 in Chew Magna, son of William Miner. He married Joan _ about 1554/9. He was a tailor and resident of Chew Magna in 1556 at which time it was known as a cloth making town. He was buried at Chew Magna on 15 November 1573. An abstract of his will, dated 20 October 1573 and proved 15 September 1574, survives. The manor court rolls show Joan succeeding her husband on 19 July 1574 under a grant of 29 June 1554. She was buried at Chew Magna on 21 December 1592.

Thomas MINER, son of Clement MINER, immigrated in 1629 aboard "*Lyon's Whelp*", sailing from Gravesend 25 Apr 1629, with "forty planters out of the Counties of Dorset and Somerset", and arrived at Salem in the middle of July. Shortly after his arrival in Salem a serious outbreak of Typhus Fever prompted him to relocate to Watertown, MA. This stay was also brief and Thomas moved to Charlestown where he founded the First Church in 1632. He married Grace PALMER in 1634. Their first child, John, was born in Charlestown, and then in 1636 they moved to Hingham, MA where more children were born. In 1645, they joined John Winthrop Jr. and company in the settlement of New London, CT. On 15 Oct 1652 Thomas sold his home lot in New London located at the head of Close Cove and settled in Stonington, CT.

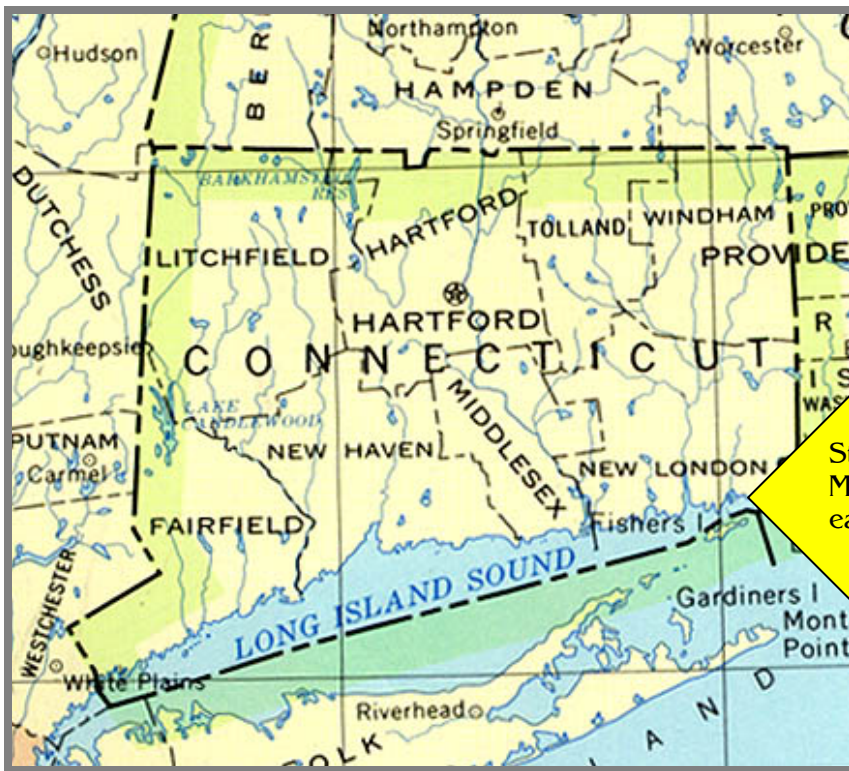
Minor was a skillful workman who built houses and branded horses for many of the local settlers. Thomas was a lieutenant in the local Connecticut militia from Feb. through April of 1676 and, along with his sons, fought in "King Philip's War". By August of that year, he had been promoted to the rank of Captain. He was 68 years old, and carried a musket into battle on numerous occasions. He died in October 1690, and his wife died two months later. They are buried together in Stonington.

In Stonington, there is a monument (see picture below) to the founders (dedicated 31 August 1899) located in the Wequetequock Cemetery with one side dedicated to Thomas.

In 1653 he bought some land from Cary Latham and moved from the Wequetequock area to the west side of the mouth of Quiambug Cove near Mystic, CT and began one of the few (about 17) diaries to survive from this period. This diary covers the period from 1653 through 1684 and was published as a book in 1899.

Interestingly, Thomas Miner sent to England for a genealogy. What he received traced his family back to the 1300's, but was largely fictitious, and provided him with a fabricated coat-of-arms.

He died in Quiambug, a part of Stonington, CT on 23 October 1690, and his wife died there on 31 December 1690. Both are buried at Stonington in the Wequetequock Cemetery under a prone, inscribed granite slab which reads "HERE LYES THE BODY OF LIUTENANT THOMAS MINORAGED 83 -- DEPARTED 1690". A picture of the slab is below.



President Ulysses S. Grant was a lineal descendant of Thomas Miner and his wife, Grace Palmer.

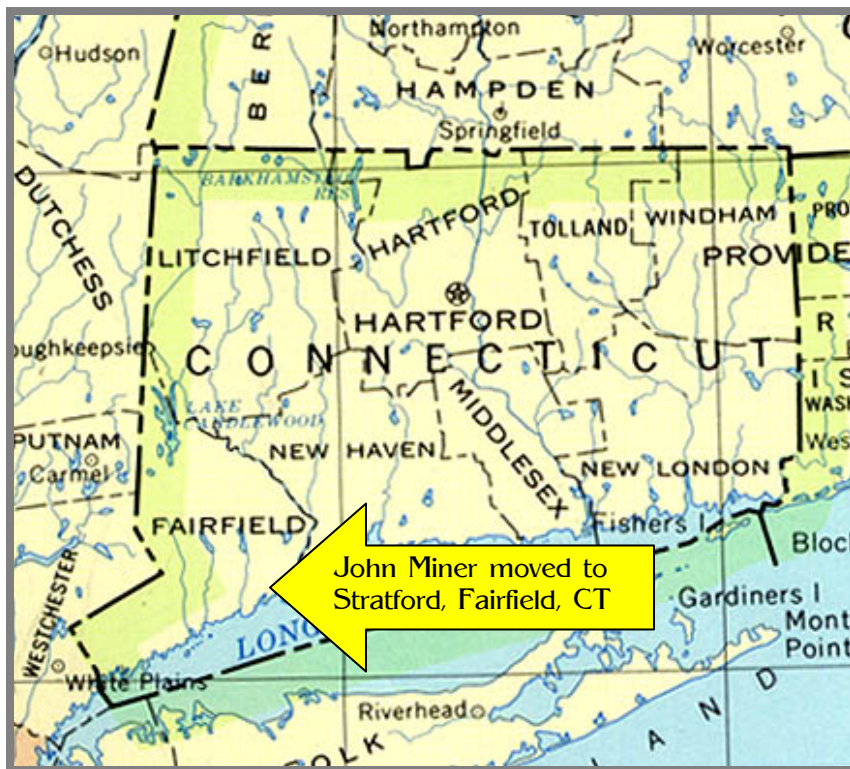

Captain JOHN MINOR was baptized on 30 Aug 1635 in Charlestown, MA, son of Thomas. He spelled his name Minor and so did some of his descendants. On 23 September 1654, John Stanton and John Minor were selected for teachers of the Gospel to the Indians. Both young men, however, ultimately left their studies. In 1658 he moved to Stratford, CT where he married Elizabeth BOOTH, daughter of Richard and Elizabeth of Stratford, on 19 Oct 1658. They settled in what is now Woodbury, CT in 1673 where he was town clerk for 30 years before dying there on 17 September 1719. She died on 24 October 1732.

He was a deputy to the Court from Stratford, CT In 1676. Some time about 1680 their family moved to Woodbury, which he represented in the General Court from 1683 to 1710. He was made a Captain o f the Litchfield Militia in 1684, and Justice of the Peace from 1698 until his death in 1719.

GIDEON MINOR was baptized in Woodbury on 2 Mar 1729. . He married Elizabeth LEWIS, widow of Joel Strong. They moved from Woodbury to Rutland, VT and late to Middletown, VT where he died on 9 Dec 1808. She died on 16 Nov 1815.

The following was taken from the history of Middletown, VT:

The mills known as "Miner's mills," in an early day were built by Gideon MINER in 1782. They were located about a mile and a half east of where the village now is. Mr. MORGAN then assisted Mr. MINER, as a workman, in building the mills. MORGAN brought the mill irons from Bennington on a horse.

In the year 1801 there was placed on the records a "roll of the freemen of Middletown and Jesse Hubbard and Gideon Miner were on it

I am not sure whether the Gideon Miner on the freemen roll was the one born in 1729 or his son born in 1771.
